## Life Lessons from the Word

**Blessed...**the final chapter of Proverbs and actually the last half of this chapter we are given insights into the blessings a family has when the wife is of noble character. This portion of Proverbs 31 begins like this, **“A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies”** (Pr. 31:10, NIV). First, we need to know what does noble character mean? From the dictionary we find the meaning of noble to be, “having or showing fine personal qualities or high moral principles and ideals.” As a Christian one could say that noble would be synonymous with Christlikeness, or righteous. Then understanding this we define character, as who we are, and again this can and does mean in this case that one has the character of Christ. With this character we see it gives her great worth. Later verses in this proverb will go onto share some of the qualities that this women of noble character brings, but here I want us to understand that the wife of noble character has and is of great value.

Our verse also eludes to the fact that this type of women may not be the norm, but special, and a great prize and pride of the one who finds them and is blessed in marrying them. I have heard it said that there is nothing worse than a bad wife, and nothing better than a good wife. Now I am sure the women could turn this around about men as well, but the point is that as our proverb points out, blessed is the man who gains a wife of noble character. So, guys, don't take it for granted, but cherish and put great value on your wife when she is of noble character, meaning when she is one who acts and lives as Christ in our lives.

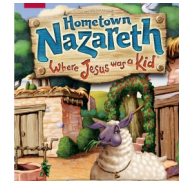

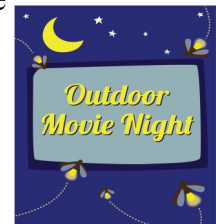
## Men's Ministry

## You Are My Witnesses

John White (1924-2002) was a medical missionary, psychiatry professor, church planter and prolific author who wrote about faith and outreach. He refuted the notion that being an effective witness for Christ is akin to being a salesperson. Christians are representing and sharing a person, he said, not touting a product.

"A good witness is like a signpost," he added. "It doesn't matter whether it is old, young, pretty, ugly. It has to point the right direction and be able to be understood. We are witnesses to Christ; we point to him."
